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Financial Assistance Scholarships

CRITERIA

You must meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrated low income
- Demonstrate attributes that will make a positive contribution to College life
- Location (preference will be given to applicants from rural or regional areas)
- Be offered and accept a place at Monash University in 2021 (scholarships will be awarded provisional on your acceptance), and intend to undertake your course as a full-time student.
- Be an Australian citizen

Please note that there is a separate application process for entering Mannix College. If you are awarded a scholarship you will be required to submit a residency application and participate in a meet and greet with the Mannix College Principal, Mr Sean Brito-Babapulle.
